## GOGGLEBOX BIBLE STUDY



Sinai Ministries is an Indian registered Christian charity which seeks to help the poorest people of Tamil Nadu in South India. The practical ministry in India is led by Pastor John and all fundraising in the UK is coordinated by our very own Reverend Moses John and his family under the name of the DaySpring Trust – a registered UK charity (no 1129247).
